TO REACH LAZY W RANCH

From Interstate 5: Exit Highway 74 (Ortega Highway) in San Juan Capistrano, proceed EAST approximately 12.5 miles. Turn LEFT at Hot Springs Canyon Road (at the LAZY W RANCH sign on LEFT) located immediately before the San Juan Forest Fire Station. Proceed 1.5 miles to the Lazy W gate.

From Interstate 15: Exit Highway 74 in Lake Elsinore, go WEST through town (following the Hwy 74 signs). Travel approximately 20 miles up the mountain. Turn RIGHT at Hot Springs Canyon Road (at the LAZY W RANCH CAMP sign on RIGHT) located immediately after the San Juan Forest Fire Station. Proceed 1.5 miles to the Lazy W gate.

Note: Hot Springs Canyon Road is a single lane, paved and unpaved road which makes several hill climbs and stream crossings before reaching the Lazy W Ranch entrance gate.

On site is a variety of recreational options: volleyball, swimming, hiking, ping-pong, horse-shoes, tetherball, basketball, and disc golf.
